Can you make a home for your Supertato. You can use any types of materials and you could label the parts of the home.

Draw a face on a potato to make your own Supertato! Take Supertato around your



house to help out with some of the jobs, such as tidying your bedroom and putting away the dishes. What other helpful things can he do?



Can you make some numbered Evil Peas? Can you order them? Can you find one more than a number?

Evil Pea is sometimes found in the freezer where it is very cold. Evil Pea needs to keep warm and sometimes finds it very tricky to do his coat up and put his gloves on. Can you practice at home too when putting your outdoor coats and gloves on so that you keep yourselves warm?



Supertato is writing a list of all his favourite vegetable and fruit friends. Can you write a list of all of your favourites for the shopping list?

Remember to have a go at using your phonics to write this by yourself first and then ask your grown-up to help you. Have your sound mat out to help ☺



When making or eating a meal, discuss which parts of the meal are vegetables and which are healthy for your body. You could also make a healthy snack such as fruit salad or a fruit smoothie. Don't forget to write down your recipe!



Supertato is learning to recognise different amounts using the words more, less or the same. Can you practice using these words with an adult at home with different amounts of objects. Here is mine. I have more blue stars than red stars.
