


Children love to learn by being active, exploring, discovering and taking risks!

Reading - Little Wandle

- On Mondays, your child will begin a new book in school. This book will
 then come home with them on a Wednesday. Please can this be
 returned on the following Monday.
- Your child will know the sounds in the book well and be able to read much of the book fluently. Listen to them read and celebrate their success together!
- Sharing book- this is their choice of a book and something to be read to them at home.
- Please can we ask for your help in taking care of our brand new books.

Phonics Screening

The Phonics Screening Check takes place in year 1, usually in June. The test contains 40 words. Some of these words are real words and some are 'non-words' or 'nonsense words'. Children will be prepared for the fact that some of the words will not be real words and these words are identifiable during the test by having a small image of an alien next to them. These 'non-words' are important because all children will need to use their decoding skills to read them as they will have not been learnt by sight. Each child will sit one-to-one with an adult and will be asked to read the 40 words out loud.
