Please choose 4 tasks to complete this half term (you can choose more if you wish). Learning logs will be collected for marking on a Thursday and returned Friday.

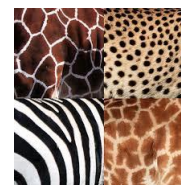
Investigate how many ways you can make these different totals. You can choose just 1 to make or have a go at all 3.
