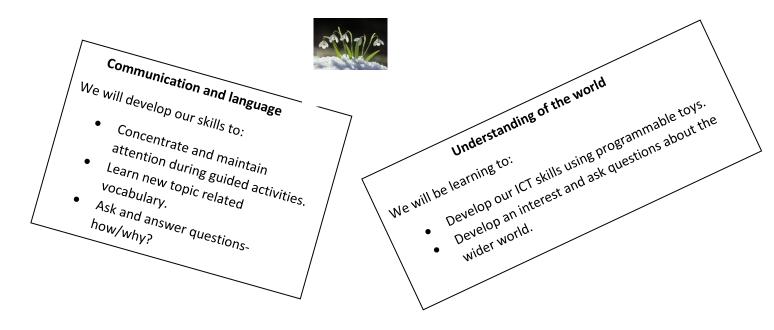
Reception Curriculum Newsletter Spring 2024

We will be:

Continuing to use the zones of regulations to help us explain and understand

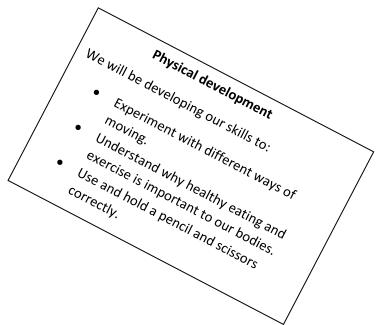


Mathematics

We will be learning to:

- Recognise and count numbers 1-20 and match the correct Know one more and one less than a given number to 20. number to a set.
- - Use language full/empty. Explore length and height.
 - - Talk about time.
 - Describe 3D shapes.





Literacy

We will be:

- Saying, recognise and form Phase 3 phonics sounds.
- Blending our sounds together to form simple words.
- Begin to write sentences that we can read.



We will be:

- Engaging in imaginative role-play, using our 'Superhero' topic to inspire our play.
- Using a variety of media and materials in our artwork,
- adapting and problem solving where necessary.



Please remember to continue to support your child across the curriculum, not only with their reading and maths activities, but also to foster their imagination, inquisitive nature and explorative play. Please read with your children at least four times a week and record this in their reading record. As January is our resolution read competition. If you read five times a week you will receive a certificate.
