

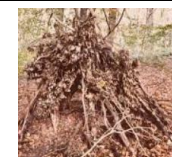
If you were a woodland creature what would you be? Could you draw your creature and label it?

Think about the different types of materials you can use outside; will the material stay dry in the rain?

With an adult find objects to measure. You can use your hands and feet to find which objects are shorter/longer and which is the shortest/longest.



Can you practice forming your numbers to 20? You can use different materials to write your numbers for example, you could paint them, use pebbles or straws.

It's time the Gruffalo had a friend. Design your own character with different features to the Gruffalo. Will they look friendly or scary?



Can you make a shopping list of all the ingredients you will need to make Gruffalo crumble? Have your sound mat out to help.
