Maths:

Research the Ancient Egyptian number system and come up with some number sentences and answers. Use a variety of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.



English:

History:

Research what types of foods the Ancient Egyptians ate. Design a menu for an Ancient Egyptian restaurant.



Design technology:

Find a recipe from Egypt (Ancient or Modern). Cook it and evaluate it. Did you enjoy it? Explain why.

Create a portrait of an Egyptian God or Goddess.



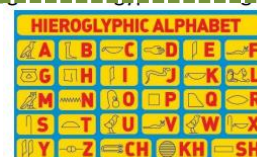
Music:
