Plan your route.

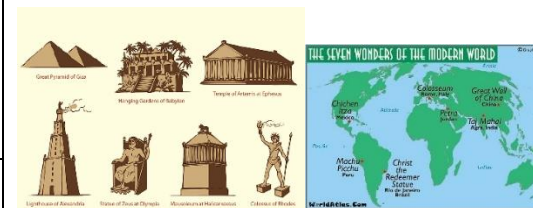
* Write a postcard and describe your visit to some of the sites in Greece which still exist from Ancient Greek time.
