FOCUS ON: Physical Education

What sports do we do in PE?



We cover a variety of sports in our lessons. These are split into -

Invasion games -Netball, Football, Basketball, Rugby, Multi skills,

Striking/fielding -Cricket, Rounders,

Gymnastics Floor -Rolling, Balance, Partner balances, Travelling Gymnastics apparatus – Vaulting, Table tops, Climbing frame

Net/wall -Tennis, Volleyball Bikes -

Balance bikes used in year 1 and 2, opportunity for bikeability in year 6

Athletics -Running, Throwing, Jumping, Relays, Sports Day, Hurdles

Dance -Rhythmic, Stimulus, Gesture, Yoga

Swimming – Year 2, 4 and 6

Target games -Golf, Boccia

Structure of lesson



Each lesson follows the same structure;

- Warm up heart raiser, mobilising and get ready for exercise
- Skill Practise introduce new skills or improve skills already learnt
- Game small sided, restricted, smaller area, attack versus defence, full sided
- Cool down stretching, recovering from exercise, evaluation

Each class gets set terms with the PE specialist to teach the lessons. They also have outside coaches who come in to teach lessons in cricket.


