

The 2026 residential visit for our Year 6 children will take place from Friday 26th to Monday 29th June, when we are looking forward to returning to Little Canada on the Isle of Wight. This is one of PGL's premier sites with a fantastic range of land activities including climbing, high ropes, muddy sensory trails, archery and abseiling together with water-based activities such as canoeing and sailing. There will also be evening activities such as games and campfire. All of the activities are supervised by qualified instructors but the children will be accompanied by school staff.

Personal and team skills, as well as social relationships are developed and it is a valuable opportunity for the children to work together and build confidence through a wide variety of exciting activities. Above all it is great fun! The centre offers good quality accommodation on a secure site. The catering is excellent, allowing children to have a hot meal three times a day which they will need, due to the number and the physical nature of the activities they do!

We do hope that you will consider booking a place for your child. The total cost of the trip this year will be between £320 and £350, depending on the number of children in the class attending. This includes coach and ferry transport, the cost of 3 nights' accommodation, all meals and morning, afternoon and evening activities each day. You can pay this in installments over the year, and we will keep you informed about the payment schedule and confirmed cost once we have an idea of the number of children attending.

If you would like your child to take part please visit your Arbor Parent Portal and pay a deposit of £40 by Wednesday 29th October. **Please note that payments are non-refundable.** If you are concerned about meeting the payments but would still like to go, please contact us to discuss this in confidence.
