You should be spending at least 10 minutes four times a week on TTRS practising your times tables.

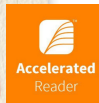
Rainforests and Explorers

These are optional tasks that can be completed throughout the term:

Design your own rainforest creature. Draw your animal and write a description of it. Think about: what it is like, where it lives (which layer of the forest), what it looks like, what it eats (diet / prey) and who hunts it (predators).

Imagine you are an explorer in the rainforest. Write a diary entry based on a day on your expedition. What did you do? What did you see? How did you feel? Try to use a variety of punctuation and different sentence structures. You could also decorate your diary entry with drawings like on the pages of our class book 'The Explorer'.
