This term, your child's school is taking part in Kent County Council's Pedestrian Road Safety Training Scheme – **SMALL STEPS**.

Your child is being offered the opportunity to take part with their class. Please read the following information.

- Training involves taking children on a risk assessed route around the local area to their school.
- Training always takes place at the roadside under the supervision of adults.
- All adults and children will wear high-visibility tops over their coats/jackets.
- Adults who have been DBS checked by the school will accompany the Small Steps Coordinator in small groups.
- Small Steps is aimed to help children become safer pedestrians; it is not intended to teach children to be independent travellers.
- Any child who is disruptive during the training will be accompanied back to school.
