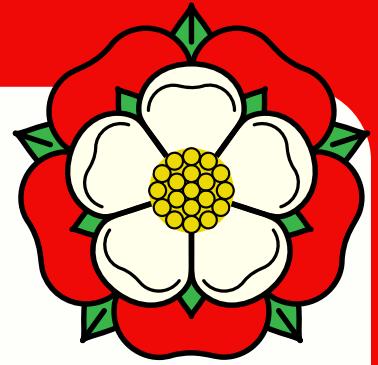

These are the tasks we expect you to be completing each week:



Times tables are very important in Year 4. You are expected to practise for at least 10 minutes, 3-4 times a week. Times Tables Rock Stars is a great way to support this, by helping you to improve your quick recall of multiplication facts and also track your progress.



Spelling Shed

Spellings will be given out at the start of term and these should be practised at home ready for the weekly test. You should also be practising some of the words from the key word list each week. Spelling Shed is a fun way to learn them.

In Year 4, you should be reading for 15 mins at least 4 times a week. Once books are completed, children can complete quizzes on Accelerated Reader.
